### Press Release

In response to the COVID-19 virus, the Barbour County Assessor's Office will be putting the following precautions in place as of March 23, 2020.

Only essential personnel will be permitted in the Assessor's Office, except by appointment.

Most business can be handled by phone. In the rare event that it can't, an appointment will be scheduled.

Personal Property Assessments- Assessments can be taken over the phone by the Assessor's Office and paid by mail or over the phone to the Sheriff's Tax Office.

Dog Tags- Dog information can be taken over the phone and a check or money order made out to "Assessor of Barbour County" can be mailed to us. Once payment is received, our office will mail your tags and receipt to you.

Goat and Sheep Fee- The number of breeding age sheep and goats can be taken over the phone. Payment can be mailed by check or money order made out to "Assessor of Barbour County". Once we receive payment, we will mail your receipt to you.

Real Estate Questions-Most questions can be answered over the phone. In the event that a property needs reassessed, we will take your information and review the property once it is safe for our employees and taxpayers.
