

ORDINANCE: 14-3d-01

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IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF BARBOUR COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA
ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANIES AND PAID FIRE
COMPANIES TO CHARGE FEES

BE IT ENACTED, an Ordinance pursuant to the provision of West Virginia Code §7-1-3d (supp. 2002), as amended, authorizing the County Commission to allow volunteer fire companies and paid fire departments within the County of Barbour, State of West Virginia, to charge reasonable reimbursement fees for personnel and equipment used in performing firefighting services, victim rescue, and cleanup of debris, and hazardous material by department personnel.

Barbour County Commission meeting this day and in compliance with the provisions of the West Virginia Constitution, and the statutes and laws of the State of West Virginia, find good cause to adopt such Ordinance in the interest of having continuous and effective fire protection for the property and citizens of Barbour County.

WHEREFORE, any volunteer fire company, and paid fire department, operating in and under the jurisdiction of the Barbour County Commission is hereby authorized to charge a reasonable fee for reimbursement for personnel and equipment used in performing firefighting services, victim rescue, cleanup of debris, and hazardous materials by fire department personnel. The rate for any such fee shall be charged to the property owner, or other person responsible or liable for payment of such services.

Further, pursuant to West Virginia Code §7-1-3d (supp. 2002), as amended, no fee for any single incident or accident shall exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00), with the exception of an incident or accident involving hazardous materials. The County Commission of Barbour County shall require that any fees charged pursuant to this

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authorization conferred by this Ordinance must be in writing, and be itemized by specific services rendered, and show the rate for each such service.

Any fire department submitting such fees as authorized by this Ordinance is hereby authorized to directly bill the property owner or other person responsible or liable for payment of such services, however the fire department shall forward a copy of such bill to the Clerk of the County Commission.

This Ordinance enacted upon by the Barbour County Commission on this the 8 day of September, 2014, and shall be made of record in the Office of the Clerk of the County Commission of Barbour County, West Virginia.
