Susie Cvechko called the work session to order.

The purpose of this work session is to discuss the ARP application process.

Shana Frey explained the policy and procedures of the application process, reviewed the application and application manual. The first round of applications will be open on September 20, 2021 and close on March 31, 2022. The second round is to be determined. Only online submissions will be accepted. Shana noted that the County Commission is utilizing the State Auditor's ARP application software and that any applications toward the ARP funds will be submitted through this process.

Applications will be reviewed for completeness, then for eligibility. The US Treasury is still reviewing comments on the Interim Rule and is expecting the review to go into the Fall. The current Interim Rule guidelines will be honored in the event of a change. It was pointed out that a question on the application is to identify the section of the Interim Rule in which your project is eligible under.

Reporting requirements were discussed for awarded projects.

Susie Cvechko opened the session for discussion.
